



COVID UPDATE – Return to School Plan

Dear Students and Parents / Carers

On Friday 27th August 2021 the NSW Department of Education announced a Return to School Plan for all schools in Greater Sydney. This plan is subject to NSW Health advice and dependent upon the stay-at-home rules for LGAs of concern. Obviously, there will be a great deal of discussion and planning around how the return will be organised, but it is hoped the following plan will be implemented.

Year 12 students will continue remote learning until the end of Week 3, Term 4. On Monday 25th October 2021 (Week 4, Term 4), Year 12 will return to school for some face-to-face learning until the HSC examinations start on the revised date, Tuesday 9th November 2021.

Year 11 students will continue remote learning until the end of Week 4, Term 4. On Monday 1st November 2021 (Week 5, Term 4), Year 11 will return to school for some face-to-face learning in order to begin their HSC curriculum.

Years 7 – 10 students will continue remote learning until the end of Week 5, Term 4. On Monday 8th November 2021 (Week 5, Term 4), Years 7, 8, 9 & 10 will return to school for some face-to-face learning.

Whilst at school, students will be required to follow all NSW Health Guidelines. Further information can be found at
