## Upcoming stormwater connection works and pedestrian (B-Class) hoarding dismantling works

Dear school community and local residents,

We are writing to inform you that planned works are soon to commence at the former Arthur Phillip High School site as part of the final stage of the redevelopment project.

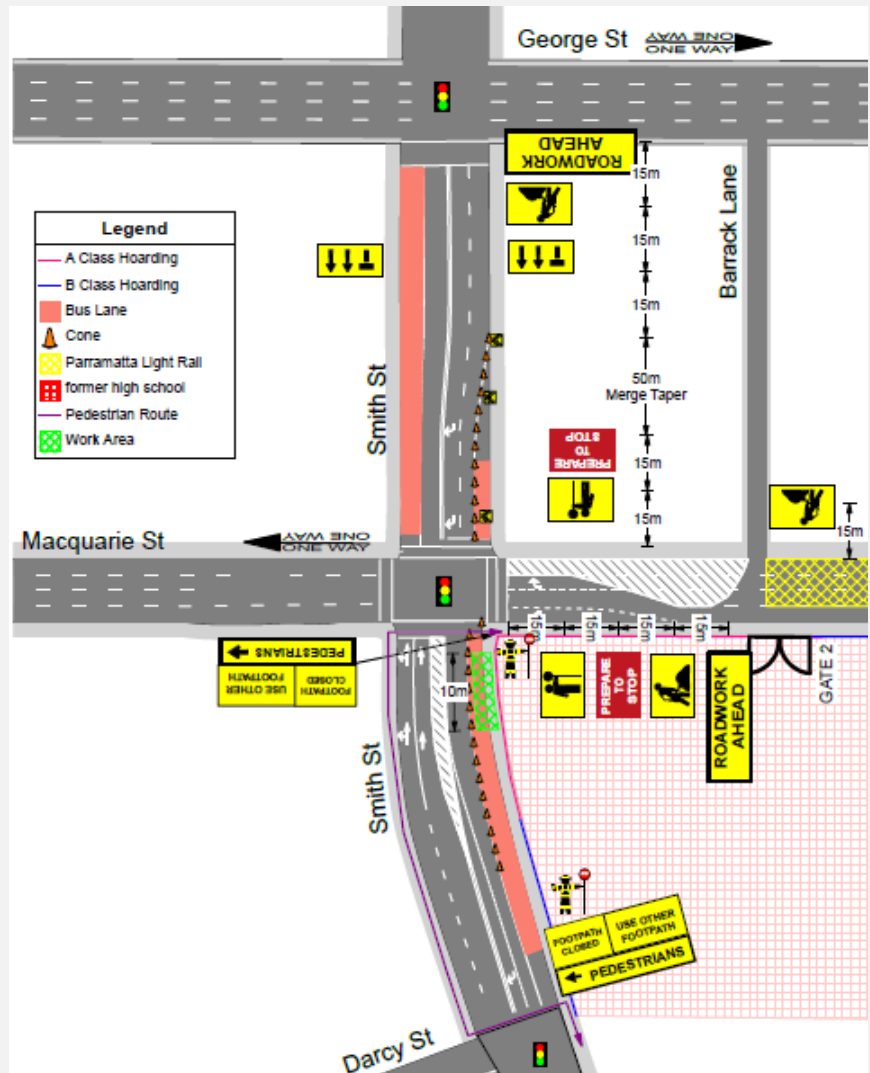
### Stormwater connection works

The footpath and kerbside lane along Smith Street will be temporarily closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic to allow for the installation of new stormwater pipes. The night time works will take place between **Monday, 15 June 2020** and **Friday, 19 June 2020** between 8:00pm to 5:00am, weather permitting.

The Smith Street footpath and kerbside lane will reopen during the day for vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

Temporary pedestrian diversions and traffic management will be in place while the works take place.

Please see figure on the right highlighting the areas to be temporarily closed for proposed works.

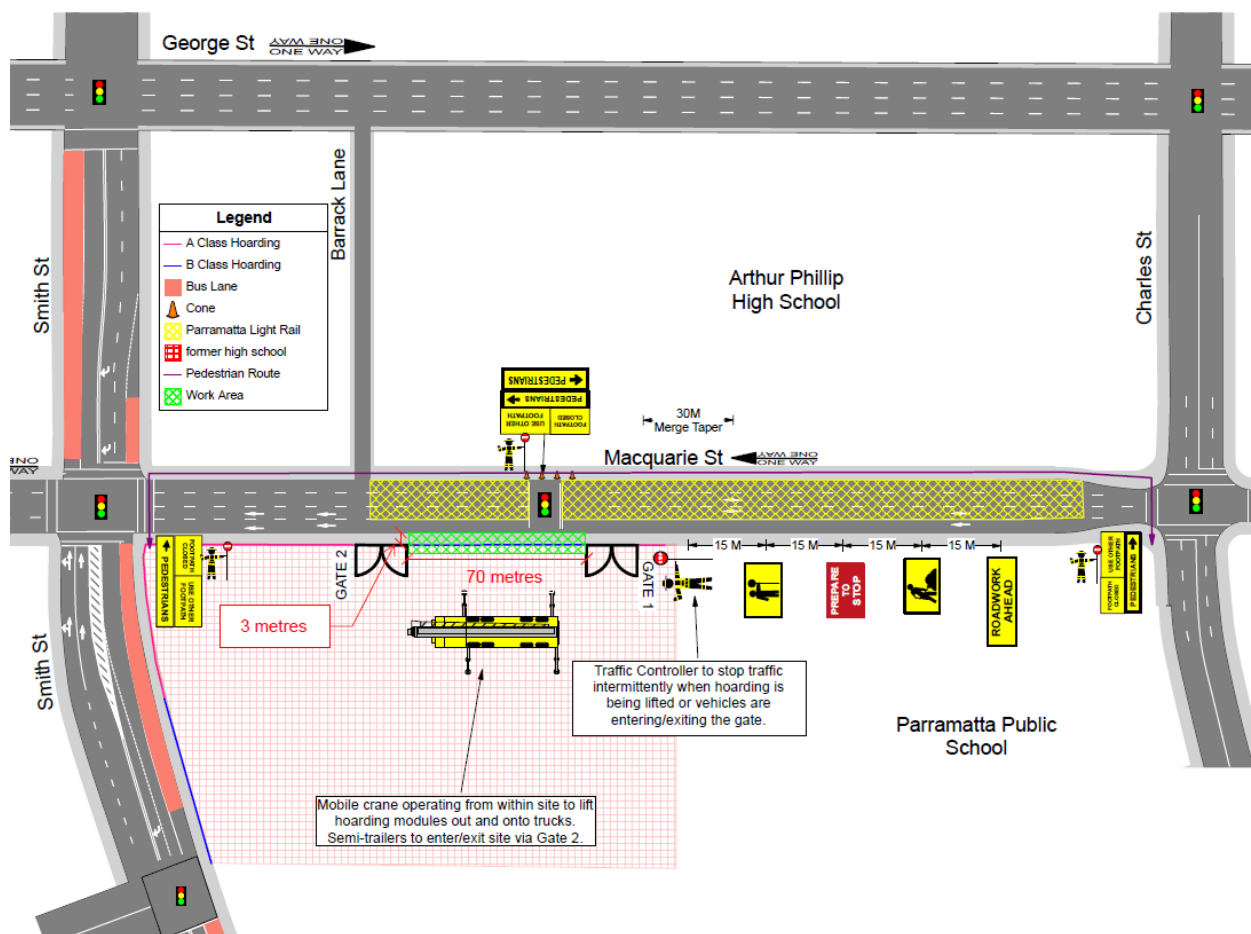


## Macquarie Street pedestrian (B-Class) hoarding dismantling works

The footpath along Macquarie Street will be temporarily closed to pedestrian traffic to allow for the dismantling of the pedestrian (B-Class) hoarding. The hoarding was in place during the demolition works of the former high school site. The buildings along Macquarie Street have now been demolished and the temporary hoardings can be removed. The day time works are anticipated to take place on **Monday, 22 June 2020** and **Tuesday, 23 June 2020** between 7:00am to 6:00pm, weather permitting and subject to council approval.

Temporary pedestrian diversions and traffic management will be in place while the hoarding modules are dismantled and removed.
