CO-PRINCIPAL

YEAR 7 to 10 ACCESSING HOME LEVELS

To assist with movement within the school and to address some Health and Safety issues, all students from Years 7 to 10 will be required to use the stairs to access their home levels each day from the commencement of Term 2. Lift access will only be available when students are travelling to Level 9 for Science Practical work. If for any reason a student in Year 7 to 10 requires the lifts to be accessible due to a medical or other reason, then special application can be made for a lift pass supported by the appropriate documentation. Students who currently have a lift pass do not need to reapply.

AREAS TO BE ACCESSED DURING BREAKS

During breaks students are able to access the upper ground level or stay on a home base level if they wish. From the start of Term 2 the following will apply for students who wish to remain on a level during their break:

Stage 4 (Year 7 and 8)

Stage 5 (Year 9 and 10)

Stage 6 (Year 11 and 12)

Level 2 only

Level 6 only

Level 8 only

Students must remain on one of the levels or go to Upper Ground where staff will be rostered on to supervise.

A reminder that students are not permitted to be on Levels, 1, 5 or 9 unless they have timetabled lesson on that floor.
